### 2019 Fall Courses

Wow! What an interesting and challenging Spring Semester this has been.

Thank you for your patience, understanding and flexibility as we have had to deal with extreme cold, ice storms, flooding, illness and larger than anticipated enrollment. All of these have meant that we have had to make changes in our courses this spring.

Please remember that we really appreciate knowing in advance if you cannot attend a course for which you have signed up. We set up (and often pay rent to) venues based on enrollment numbers. Also, our presenters often would like to know how many people will be in attendance. It can be embarrassing and not very cost effective when the actual numbers are significantly different from the enrollment numbers.
